### **Guidelines / Qualifications for awarding scholarship:**

- 1. The applicant must be a Lauderdale County resident.
- 2. The applicant must be pursuing a degree in Forestry or a Forest Resource major.
- 3. The applicant must be a full-time student entering at the freshman or higher level at a college or university.
- 4. The successful recipient may re-apply for following years, if a 3.0 GPA in forestry and 2.5 overall GPA or better is maintained.

#### **Application:**

- 1. Completed application form must be signed by the applicant and submitted by or before **April 1st.**
- 2. Applicant must provide a copy of high school and/or college transcript.
- 3. Applicant must submit a 1–2-page essay explaining his/her interest in their field of study along with the student's long-term goals for his/her future in their field.
- 4. Applicant must submit 2-3 letters of personal recommendation from school, church, or community leaders.
- 5. Applicant must submit a Statement of financial condition (Include plans of financing your education).

#### **Process:**

- 1. In the spring of each year, a scholarship announcement and form will be sent to the local high schools, community colleges and universities in Mississippi that offer a forestry program.
- 2. Forms can be received from the LCFA and must be returned to the LCFA by April 1st.
- 3. Forms will be reviewed by the scholarship committee and their selection will be final. All applicants and recipients will be notified of results.
- 4. Upon proof of registration in the fall, a \$1,000 check will be made payable to the school on behalf of the student.
